Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the Kiama Community Safety Committee, the committee will be a newly formed committee of Council and coincide with the development of Council's new Community Safety and Crime Prevention Plan.

Purpose of the Committee:

The purpose of the community safety committee is to:

- To implement strategies that help people feel safe in the community
- To achieve low rates of crime throughout the Municipality
- To develop, implement and monitor a Community Safety Plan
- To monitor and review the operation of the street surveillance system, its policies and procedures
- To identify and consider potential crime prevention strategies
- To provide a forum for issue identification and discussion
- To develop and implement a coordinated and prioritised work program for the Committee

Committee structure:

- Minimum of one nominated Councillor (plus Councillor alternate)
- Up to 2 community representatives
- A representative of the NSW Police
- A representative of:
 - the Southern and Central Precincts,
 - the Jamberoo Residents and Ratepayers Association, and
 - the Minnamurra Progress Association.
- Minimum of one representative from Department of Corporate, Commercial and Community Services.
- Other Council officers as required.

Appointment: Members will be formally appointed by Council.

Meeting frequency:

The Committee will meet every 3 months on a Thursday evening 5.30pm to 7.30pm

Additional meetings may be held at various days and times as required for projects involving the Committee.
