- (b) Certificate of Compliance application fee of \$50 applies.
- (c) Under the provisions of Section 26 of the *Swimming Pools Act 1992* the applicant is entitled to appeal to the Land and Environment Court against the local authority's decision or failure to make a decision.
- (d) Such appeal must be made within twenty-eight (28) days of decision being issued or within six (6) weeks from request lodgement where a decision has failed to be issued.
