### **Labourers, Waste Services Grade 4, Casual, Ref. S40.007335**

Council's Waste Services Labourers are responsible for:

- Cleaning public amenities and facilities
- Carrying out minor maintenance
- Completing cleaning related reports as required
- Undertaking maintenance duties at Minnamurra and Gerroa Depots

The successful applicants will need to have a Class C Driver's Licence (Manual) and at least 12 months experience cleaning public amenities, lawn mowing, gardening and tree planting. The position is classified at Grade 4 of Council's Salary Structure and the commencing rate of pay is \$24.48 per hour, including 25% casual loading.

### **Labourer/Drivers, Waste Services Grade 4/5/6/7 depending on vehicles driven, licences & skills required, Casual, Ref. S40.007.332**

Council's Waste Services Labourer/Drivers are responsible for:

- Collecting litter from Council's streets, parks and reserves
- Operating Council's trucks for internal and external hire
- Ensuring trucks and equipment are serviced and maintained to a safe and operational standard

The successful applicants will need to have a Class HR Driver's Licence and experience driving heavy vehicles requiring a HR Driver's Licence. Rates of pay vary depending on the vehicles driven, licences and skills required.
