Busking in

Kiama is encouraged.

If you wish to busk in Kiama you must obtain a permit from Council first.



Permits are available from our Administration Centre at 11 Manning Street, Kiama.

Apply for a permit

1. Read our [Busking Policy and Guidelines](#)
2. Submit a completed [Busking application form](#) (parental consent required if you are under 18)
3. Pay the required fee:
 - a. \$16 per quarter or
 - b. \$47.00 per annum or
 - c. \$26 annual renewal.
4. Supply a portrait photo of yourself with your application.

If your application is approved, you will be issued with a permit.

When performing you must:

1. Display your Busking Permit in a highly visible place
2. Comply with our [Busking Policy and Guidelines](#) at all times.
