1 NSW Local Government Association Annual Conference and National General Assembly of Local Government Conference (C15.001.000, C15.004.000) Determination of any Notice of Motions that Council wishes to Submit to the Conferences

Councillor Jones has submitted the following Notice of Motion for Council's consideration:-

That Council amend the motion regarding the Killalea State Recreation Area included in CR262 of the Extraordinary Meeting of Tuesday 7 August 2007 as outlined below so as to more properly reflect in the proposed conference motion, the matters raised in the background material attached to the original motion.

That the Association:-

- a)
 - (i) campaign to ensure that commercial developments proposed on crown land are compatible with the general use of the crown land for public purposes and are of a scale and nature that do not alienate these areas from people who have traditionally used them, both local and visitors to the area.
 - (ii) campaigns for more open and transparent processes when commercial activities of any sort are proposed in State Recreation Areas and in so doing ensure that the Government is subject to the same level of public accountability as is Local Government in its dealings with public land under its care, and
 - (iii) campaigns to ensure that profits from public land are returned to the community and that leasing arrangements do not lead to inappropriate speculation and private profit at the expense of the community
- b) requests the LGA to invite representations from community groups which are concerned about the implications of the matters raised in part (A)

NOTE FROM MOVER: *The amendment will not change the substance of the motion but it will bring within the motion important matters raised in the background material and will more clearly focus on issues which have relevance across the whole of Local Government with respect to the management of public lands.*
