Our Emergency Plan

In NSW, Emergency Management Plans (EMPLAN) are developed to ensure a coordinated response can be made during an emergency.

The [Illawarra Emergency Management Plan](#) covers Kiama, Shellharbour and Wollongong Local Government Areas.

It outlines:

- who is responsible for responding in an emergency
- what tasks need to happen.

Kiama Council is a member of the Illawarra Local Emergency Management Committee

(LEMC).

The committee meets 3 times a year and is chaired by a senior Council representative.
