- and including a condition of consent that requires the installation by the applicant of a 1.8 metre high fence along the eastern boundary of the site

  3. acknowledges community concerns about parking and traffic management during the development of the site and the operation of the site. Council will undertake an investigation of traffic and parking management on Belinda Street and surrounds, following 12 months after site is open for commercial operation.
