When something is accessible, it means you can enter a place or building. Or, you can use a service or get information.

We have worked out how accessible places are and put them in different groups.

These groups are:



easy – accessible



• medium – you might need help from someone else



• hard – you will need help from someone else



not accessible.

You might find some places easier or harder to get to than what this guide says. Not all places will be fully accessible. This guide will help you decide if a place is accessible to you.

Wheelchairs for the beach



- There are 2 places where you can get a wheelchair to use on the beach in Kiama. There is:
 - 1 wheelchair at Seven Mile Beach Holiday Park
 - 1 wheelchair at Surf Beach Life Saving Club.
- If you need a wheelchair to get onto Seven Mile Beach, you can ask staff at the holiday park office.
- If you need a wheelchair to get onto Surf Beach, you can ask:
 - a lifesaver
 - someone at the kiosk.











A defibrillator is a machine that helps people who are having problems with their heart.

It uses electricity to:

- fix a person's heartbeat if it is too slow or too fast
- start a person's heart again if it has stopped.

On the right is a list of places where you can find a defibrillator if you need one.

There is an adult change table at Kiama Boat Ramp with an electric hoist.

You need a **MLAK Key** to get in.

A MLAK key lets people with disability get into places, like accessible toilets that might be locked.

You can get a MLAK Key from the:

- Kiama Council Administration Centre
- Kiama Visitor Information Centre.

The Kiama Train Station has:

- accessible car parking
- a lift
- direct support at any time of the day or night
- an accessible toilet
- a boarding ramp
- a hearing loop system a special way to communicate to people who wear hearing aids
- stairs with handrails
- colour-contrasted tactile indicators.

Colour-contrasted tactile indicators are important for people with low vision to help them get around.

They make the path look different through:

- colours
- bumps on the path.
