#### MINUTES OF THE KIAMA LOCAL TRAFFIC COMMITTEE 5 OCTOBER 2021

**Resolved** that the Kiama Local Traffic Committee approve the temporary closure of Bourool Lane, Kiama from 25 October 2021 to 2 November 2021 (with no closure on the Sunday in-between) between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., subject to the inclusion of the following conditions:

- The Permit Holder shall have current at all times insurance in the sum of no less than \$20,000,000.00. The policy shall indemnify Kiama Council from all costs and/or claims resulting from any actions of the contractor.
- Should the permit holder, supervisor, contractor or sub-contractor fail to comply with any conditions of the permit, the permit may be revoked by Council, pursuant to Section 140 of the Roads Act 1993.
- 3. Road closure shall only occur during approved work dates and times. The road is to be returned to a trafficable condition outside of these dates and times.
- 4. Immediately following the direction of any Council and/or emergency services officers, road plates shall be installed over all excavations, the road way cleared of all plant & materials and then opened to traffic. A sufficient amount of appropriately sized road plates shall be located in close vicinity of excavations at all times.
- Subject to the discretion of the Roads Authority, days lost over the permit
  period due to inclement weather may be made up at the expiration of permit.
  Written consent of the Roads Authority shall be obtained prior to undertaking
  works.



#### **BACKGROUND**


The Kiama Show Society will be holding the Kiama Show in the Kiama Showgrounds on Friday 21 January and Saturday 22 January 2022.






- Blackwood Street From Michael Cronin Oval carpark entrance to Fern Street;

- Noble Street






That the Committee approves the installation of signage and linemarking as proposed to create formalised timed restricted parking spaces at the Gerringong Library and Museum.

#### BACKGROUND

Council have recently opened the new Gerringong Library & Museum (GLaM) building on Blackwood Street, Gerringong. As part of the facility upgrade, 17 new formal carparking spaces have been created that includes 2 accessible spaces for users of the facility.

It is proposed that 2 hour time restrictions be applied to the parking spaces (excluding accessible spaces) to avoid the customers and staff of the adjacent shopping centre from parking long term in these spaces.
